Wondering what to do with that old television, computer monitor or appliance that is broken, unwanted or unused and just taking up space?

Bring them to **Holy Trinity on June 27<sup>th</sup>**. You will pay a minimal collection fee to dispose of each item. (*Collection fees are listed below*). We have found a Massachusetts company that will recycle the items in an environmentally responsible way.

**Why pay a fee to recycle?** Many towns do not have a curbside pick-up for electronic items. If they do, collections must be arranged in advance or brought to a recycling facility on infrequently scheduled days.

**Why recycle at HTOC?** It's cheap and convenient! It is also a great opportunity to support our Cathedral by delivering revenue to the Centennial Fund for planned Cathedral repairs and restoration.

### **How can you help?**

- Clean out those basements, attics, garages and warehouses and bring your items to HTOC on June 27<sup>th</sup>.
- Contact all of your friends and neighbors and encourage them to participate.
- Offer to transport items for friends on that day (collect fees with items)
- Publicize the recycling fundraiser at your workplace and speak with your business manager about a company collection. Pick-ups of items totaling \$100 or more can be arranged (within 10 miles of HTOC).

### COLLECTION FEES PER ITEM RECYCLED

#### **\$1.00 COLLECTION FEE**

All calculators, typewriters, fax/copy machines, printers, telephones, cameras, video/audio/dvd/vcr, video game units

#### **\$5.00 COLLECTION FEE**

All computer monitors, laptops, CPU, copy machines, microwaves, sink disposal units

#### **\$10.00 COLLECTION FEE**

All televisions, refrigerators, water coolers, air conditioners, freezers, dehumidifiers, stoves, washers/dryers, water heaters, dishwashers

#### **NO FEE DONATION ITEMS**

All video games, computer parts and accessories, plugs, wires, drives, DVD's, CD's and VHS tapes
